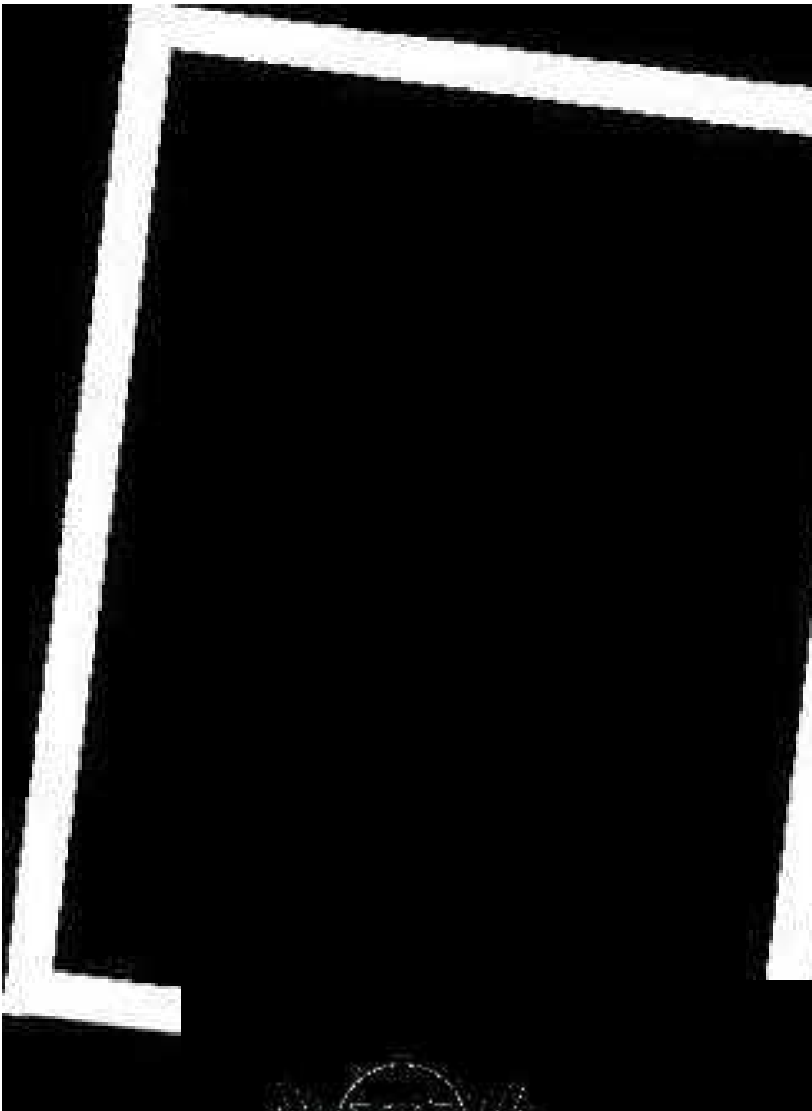

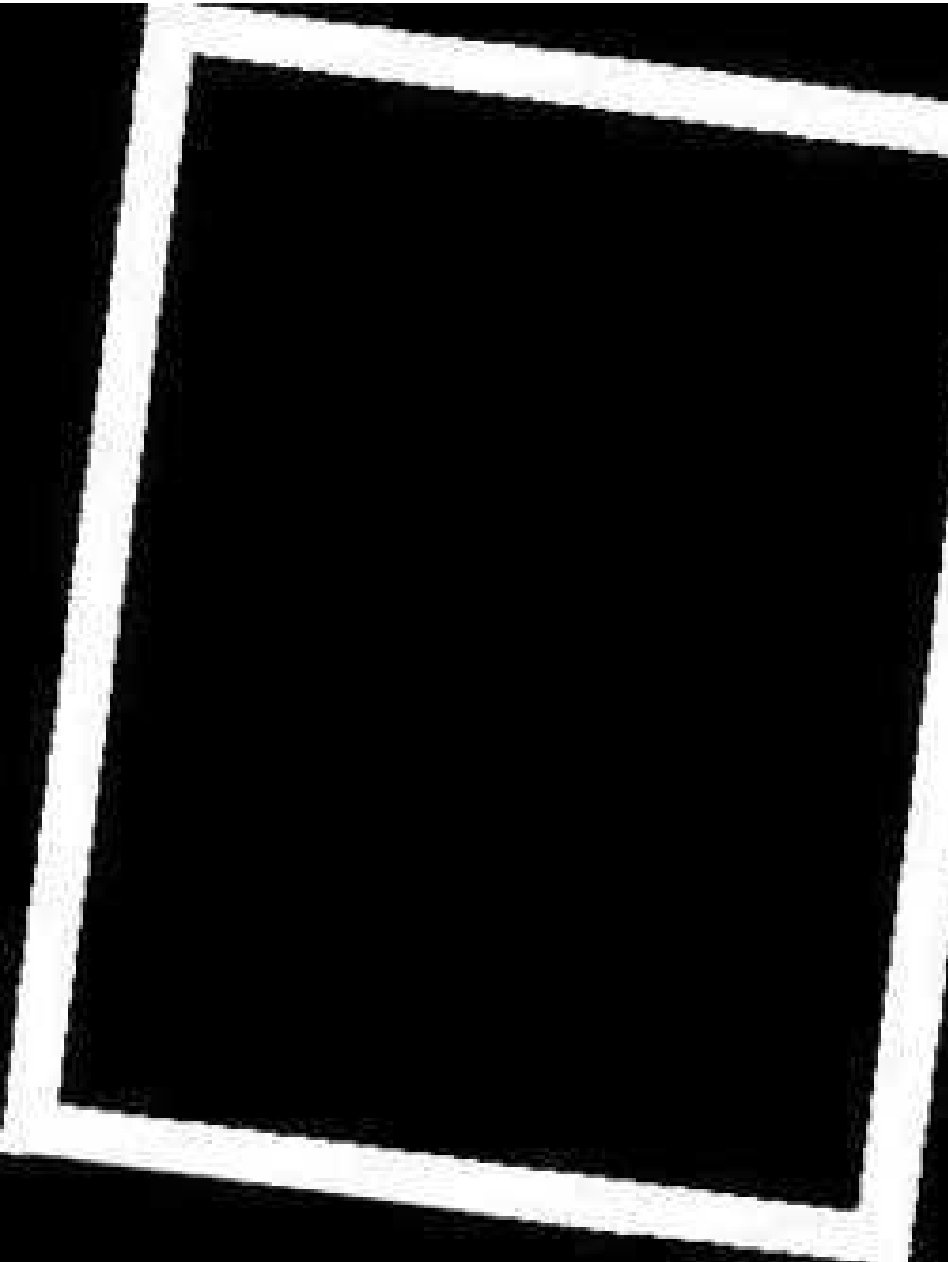

Discover a Quaint and Beautiful Village...

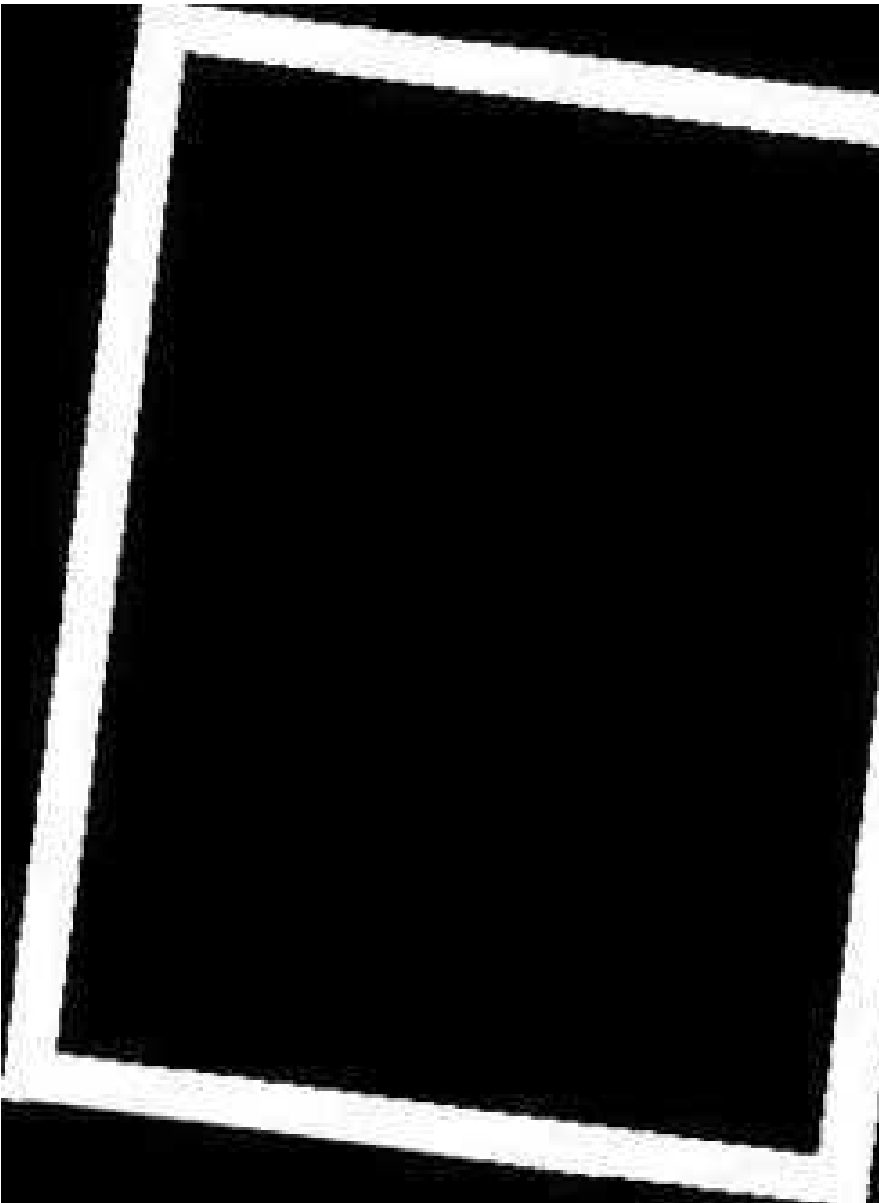
